

Fast, Easy, and Colorful Covers for Poles



Step 1

To cover bare poles on base plates, pre-inflate a 660 and let the air out to make it stretchy and easy to work with then snip off the rolled neck. Place tape on the end of the pole to cover sharp spots and slide the 660 over the top and pull and smooth it onto the pole. It can stretch up to 5 foot! To hold the 660 cover in place, you can use the rolled neck like a rubber band at the base or tie it securely with a section of 260. If you need to insert aluminum rod into the top of the pole to make an arch, be sure to tie another section of 260 near the top of the pole so it won't tear and slide downward when you do. This technique is fast, inexpensive and beautifully matches every time!
