# What You'll Need

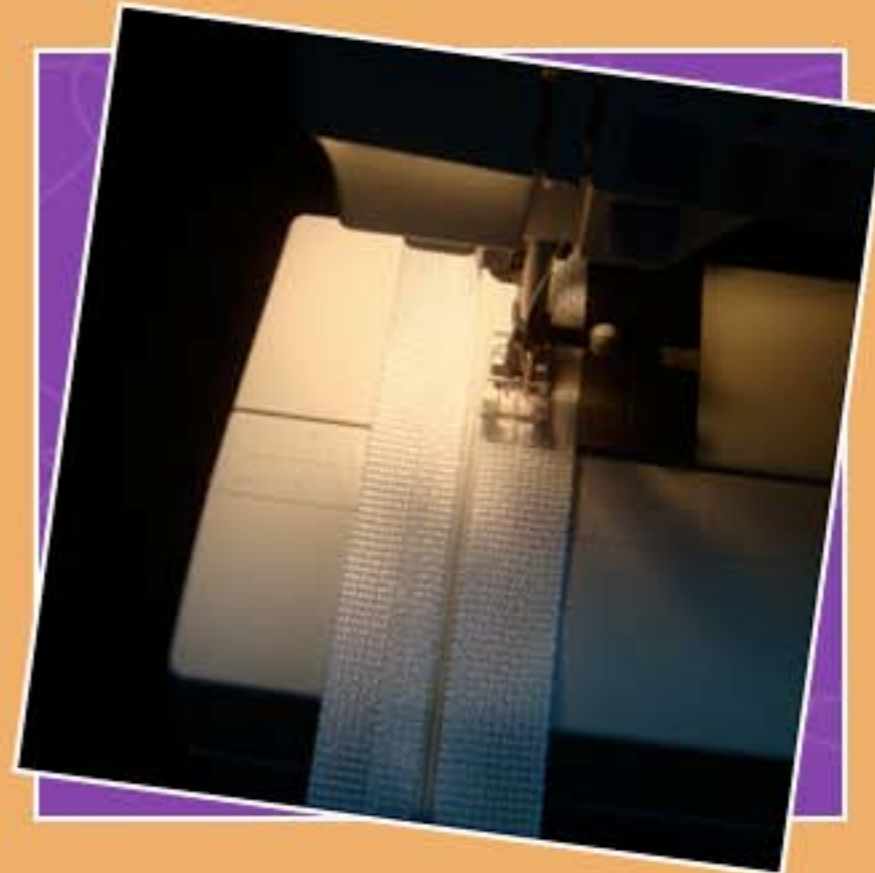


- 14" Plastic Zipper
- 28 Dungaree Buttons
- 30" Nylon Webbing





# Zipper Manufacturing



- *Cut webbing into 2 - 15" lengths*
- *Machine stitch webbing to zipper using zig-zag or similar stitch.*





# Zipper Manufacturing cont.



- *On the back of the webbing, mark 1" intervals and centers on both sides.*
- *Following directions on packaging, attach dungaree buttons down center of webbing on both sides.*

## Putting It To Use



- Use un-inflated balloons to hold your zipper in place when starting your “garment.”





- *Attach a 160B directly to the first dungaree button by wrapping the nozzle end around several times to begin your row.*
- *To complete the row, simply tie off the final bubble and attach to the dungaree button by securing.*





- *Repeat for all rows until all dungaree buttons are used.*







- *Row 15 - next after zipper - Start this row with a pinch twist and continue as usual. ;)*





# Voilà!



- *Dresses will now be much easier to get in and out of!*
